Whether taking a long run to the deep hole where the big fish swim, or adventuring for several days while fishing, kayaking, camping, or hunting, the Alaskan gets you there comfortably. With a standard 85 gallon fuel tank on the 24' and a 127 gallon tank on the 26', the Alaskan is designed to take you where many boats cannot. The 36" side height adds to the overall roominess and ensures safety for passengers. Fold out sleeper seats allow for water camping, and the enclosed marine head is ideal when nature calls. The hard top cabin easily resists rain, wind, and sea spray.

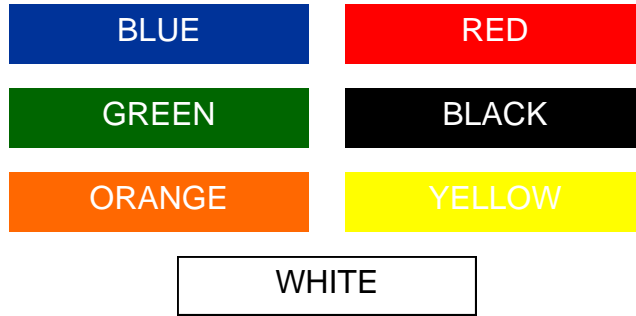

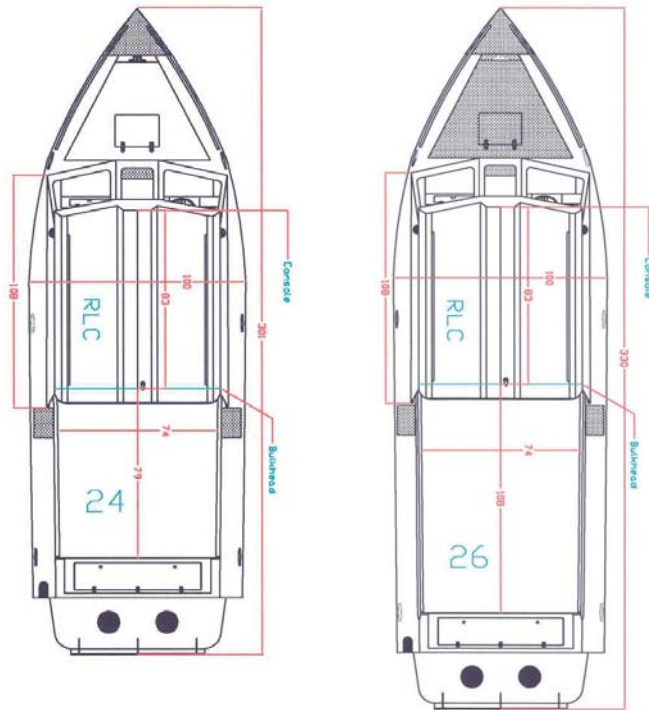
